Club Member's Child Scholarship Criteria for 2012

- I. **Purpose:** The club wishes to provide a scholarship for an individual high school senior planning on attending a college in the fall and their parent is an active member of the Springville Field and Stream. The applicant must have worked at least two of the club's functions/work days in the previous year (this will take effect in 2013).
- II. **Financial Amount:** The club will award a minimum of \$ 250.00 to the high school senior that meets all the criteria found in the criteria section of this document. The club may give more than one scholarship each year if the club's finances provide for such a situation and it is voted on by the general membership of the club and passed by a majority.
- III. **Scholarship Criteria:**
 - a. Student must be a student in good academic standing in the high school and have an average of least 71% or higher.
 - b. Student must graduate in June of the year of the scholarship award.
 - c. Student must be attending a college in the fall of the year of the scholarship award.
 - d. Student must write a letter to the Springville Field and Stream Club explaining why they feel they would be the best candidate for this scholarship. The letter must be written on white 8 ½ X 11 paper and contain not more that 400 words.
- IV. **Student's Application Letter:** The letter is to be given to the Springville Field and Stream Club the first Friday in June. The Scholarship Committee chairman will convene a meeting of the committee and the committee will decide the winner(s) of the scholarship(s). **The student's letter must be given to Richard Kazmark (592-3849) or Gary Ebert (474-2042) by Friday, June 1, 2012.**
- V. **Letter and Judging Criteria:** Applicant(s) need(s) to explain their goals for continuing education as they relate to the Springville Field & Stream Club's main objective. The Springville Field and Stream Club's main objective states: the objective of this club shall be the encouragement of an organized effort to restore and conserve wildlife, to promote and develop better marksmanship among members of the club and community, with a view toward the safe and proper handling of firearms and less wounding of game of all kinds, to stimulate fellowship, self-discipline, team play, and self-reliance, which are essentials of good sportsmanship and the foundation of true patriotism.
- VI. **Point system to be used to judge the applicant's letter. Applicants should write about these items in their letter.**
 - a. 10 points for being an active junior member of the Field and Stream Club
 - b. 10 points having a parent that's an active member of the Field and Stream Club
 - c. 10 Points for a 91 – 100 average, 8 points for a 81-90 average, 6 points for a 71 – 80 average
 - d. 10 points for being active in other organizations.(Ex. Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts, 4-H, other)
 - e. 10 points for community service (Ex. assisting in their home church, helping to collect food for the area food pantry, assisting in cleaning up their village/town area, collecting clothes for the needy, etc.)
 - f. 10 points for an excellent letter, 8 points for a satisfactory letter, 5 points for a poor letter
 - g. 10 points for having taken the NYSDEC Safe Hunter Course

VII. **Announcement of Winner:** The Scholarship Committee for the Springville Field and Stream will announce the winner or winners of the club member's scholarship(s) in the month of June/July.
